

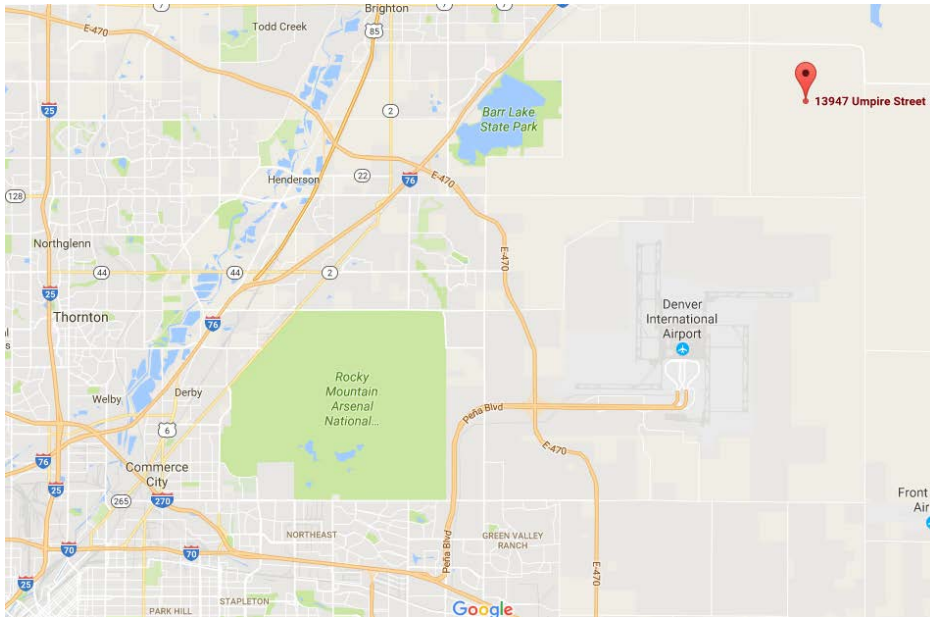

Directions to 13947 Umpire Street, Brighton, CO 80603. From Denver:

- I-76 East to exit 22/Bromley Lane.
- Turn right (east), cross the RR tracks and continue for 8 miles. (Bromley Lane becomes 152nd.)
- You will see Umpire on your right but don't turn there because it doesn't go through.
- Turn right (south) on Watkins Rd.
- Turn right on 140th Way. As it curves to the left it becomes Umpire.
- House is on the right, set back from the road 1/10 of a mile.

From the south (Colorado Springs),

- I-25 to E-470 toll road north to I-70 East.
- Exit I-70 at Watkins.
- North one block and take Highway 36
- One mile east to Imboden.
- Imboden north 12 miles to 120th.
- Turn left/west for one mile to Watkins Rd.
- Turn right/north onto Watkins Rd. to 140th Way.
- Turn left on 140th Way. As it curves to the left it becomes Umpire.
- House is on the right, set back from the road 1/10 of a mile.

I started in sighthounds in 1974 with an Irish Wolfhound and a Saluki. My first lure coursing experience was shortly afterwards, when my Wolfhound demonstrated a keen desire to chase the lure. She eventually became the first female LCM. I currently have two IW and am hoping the youngest will take to the lure. In 1982 I obtained my ASFA judges license, and have been active judging, lure operating and generally helping out since then (both ASFA and AKC Lure trials). A few years ago, I started to judge open field events, and that was enlightening. While not a big conformation person, I do enjoy owner handling my IWs, and have had some small successes. I have put on several judging seminars and done numerous lure operator trainings. Each time I feel I have come away understanding more and have been grateful for the questions and observations of those I have tried to provide information to. Currently I am president of the Lobo Lure Coursing Club in NM and serve on the board of directors of ASFA as 1st VP. Additionally, I am on several ASFA committees including the Judges Committee, Long Range Planning, and Field Trial Improvement.

ROLL CALL and INSPECTION

1:00 pm Hounds not present at roll call will be marked absent and are not eligible for refund of entry fee.

RACE INFORMATION

All breeds will be **hand slipped** at this race meet.
All hounds will run **muzzled**. The RMIWA does NOT provide muzzles.
A limited number of racing jackets in various sizes will be available from RMIWA.
Only the following colors shall be used:
Red Jacket - White numeral "1" White Jacket - Black numeral "3" Blue
Jacket - White numeral "2" Green Jacket - White numeral "4"

ENTRY FEES

Pre-Entries: The entry fee for each hound will be \$15 if the entry is received at the Race Secretary's address listed below by **Thursday June 7, 2018**. Pre-entries may be accepted by e-mail to azendogtraining@gmail.com until Thursday, June 7 with PayPal payment to Treasurer@RMIWA.org. Add \$2 for PayPal fee Contact Race Secretary for more info.

Gate Entries will be accepted up to 30 minutes before rollcall- \$20 per hound for Day of Entries.

AWARDS Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 5th place of each breed. Trophies for Irish Wolfhound Specialty only--1st through 5th place.

ELIGIBLE HOUNDS

Hounds must be one year of age or older to be entered.
All hounds must be registered with LGRA.
Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakh, Basenji, Borzoi, Chart Polski, Cirneco dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Magyar Agar, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Silken Windhounds and Sloughi may be entered in an Official Race Meet held under these Rules and Regulations.
(Whippets are not eligible for LGRA)

Please see the Registration page for information on obtaining an LGRA Racing Number (LRN).

WORKERS - Everyone must help with a LGRA race. You can line judge (decide who comes across the line first), release, catch, foul judge (did anyone interfere?), walk the squawker back to the start, start the race. Each race of 4 hounds requires at least 14 people. 4 releasers, 4 catchers, 2 foul judges (3 preferred), 1 starter, 2 finish line judges (4 for high point race), 1 lure operator. The Race Draw, Catchers and Releasers

There are three programs with heats made up of a maximum of four dogs. Hounds run against hounds of similar WAVE or running experience in the first program. After the first program, each hound earns a score from its placement in the first program. Then hounds with the same or similar scores will race together in the second program. The third program is the final program and all similarly scored hounds will run together. The hounds will be "hand-slipped" in this race instead of being released from a starting box. One handler will release. One will "catch".

Muzzles, blankets and collars

All dogs must run with properly fitted muzzles and race blankets. RMIWA has limited blankets available. The RMIWA does not have muzzles available. You will want to obtain a muzzle for your hound or borrow one PRIOR to the race day to get him used to it. The hound may wear a flat buckle or snap collar while racing. There can be NO tags on the collar. The releaser can use a slip lead or simply hold on to the collar. The catcher will want to have a lead to retrieve the dog with. Porta potty on site. Bring shade, ex-pens and water for your hound.
