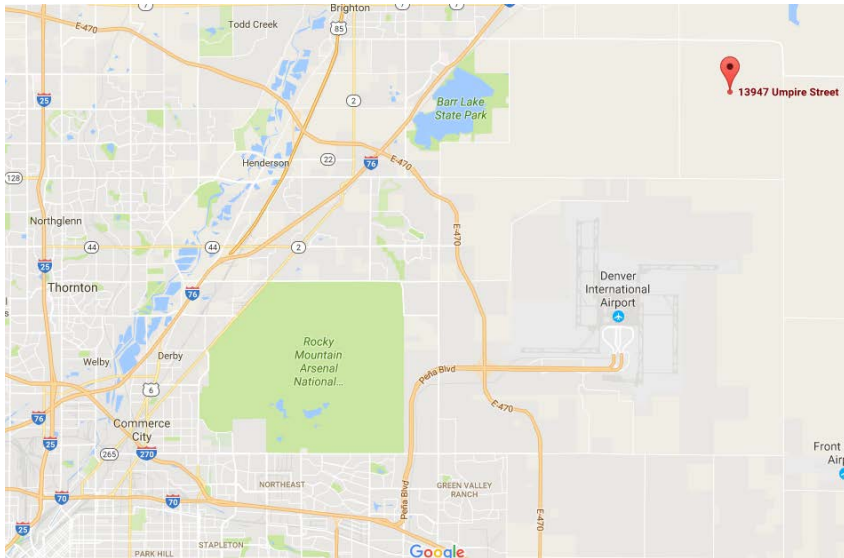
Directions to 13947 Umpire Street, Brighton, CO 80603.

From Denver:

- I-76 East to exit 22/Bromley Lane.
- Turn right (east), cross the RR tracks and continue for 8 miles. (Bromley Lane becomes 152nd.)
- You will see Umpire on your right but don't turn there because it doesn't go through.
- Turn right (south) on Watkins Rd.
- Turn right on 140th Way. As it curves to the left it becomes Umpire.
- House is on the right, set back from the road 1/10 of a mile.

From the south (Colorado Springs),

- I-25 to E-470 toll road north to I-70 East.
- Exit I-70 at Watkins.
- North one block and take Highway 36
- One mile east to Imboden.
- Imboden north 12 miles to 120th.
- Turn left/west for one mile to Watkins Rd.
- Turn right/north onto Watkins Rd. to 140th Way.
- Turn left on 140th Way. As it curves to the left it becomes Umpire.
- House is on the right, set back from the road 1/10 of a mile.

Note: The Edwards Farm in short grass prairie and does not experience as much snow typically as other areas of the front range. The property is fully fenced and gated. The Trial run area will also be fenced with vinyl barrier.

Ribbons/Awards A light blue participation ribbon will be awarded to each dog that completes the 100 yard dash. Fastest top 3 runners of each test (with handicap conversions factored in) will be awarded a ribbon and a dog toy. New Title Ribbons will be available for those dogs qualifying for a title.

ELIGIBLE DOGS

Fast CAT events are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate. Females in season may not participate. Refunds will be given for lameness or in-season females.

RMIWA Trial Specifications

- ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNERS SOLE RISK
- All entries must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the test.
- Dogs will NOT be required to wear muzzles
- White and/or black plastic bags will be used for the lure.
- Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test, and in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded.
- All AKC Rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply.
- This is a rain-or-shine outdoor event. Please plan accordingly.
- Please bring your own shade, chairs and water. (A baby pool with water will be available for cooling dogs, if needed.)
- An electric timer will be used. An electric, continuous loop, plastic strip lure machine will be used.
- Porta potty will be provided.
- Dogs must be on lead or crated unless running.
- A \$5 fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field not competing or for not picking up after your dog.
- You are responsible for controlling your dog(s) and children.
- Each dog requires an individual entry form for each event in which it is entered. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures, or the "Agreement" found on the Official AKC Entry Form
- Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused. Entry fees will be refunded.
- The Huntmaster is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, he/she has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve a testing dog.
- Dogs should be warmed up before and cooled down after running.

ABOUT FAST CAT

Fast CAT is a timed straight 100-yard dash for dogs.

Dogs are held at the start line and the coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to follow chasing it to the finish line and into a catch pen. The course is completely fenced and dogs are run individually.

Dogs are timed when they complete the 100-yard dash. The time is converted to Miles Per Hour (MPH).

Based on the dog's size at the withers a handicap is applied and points are earned:

FORMULA: MPH X HANDICAP = POINTS

Titles are earned at specific point levels and the highest suffix may appear after the dog's name:

Handicap based on height of dog

- 18" or greater = Handicap is 1.0
 - 12" up to less than 18" = Handicap is 1.5
 - Below 12" = Handicap is 2.0
- BCAT = 150 points
 DCAT = 500 points
 FCAT = 1,000 points
 FCAT# = Each additional 500 points

Top 20 by Breed by Year: The AKC Fast CAT website will feature the Top 20 Fastest Dogs by Breed by Year national standings. The standings will be updated as event results are processed.

10 Tips for Beginners (and Reminders for those with experience) --

- Bring 2 leashes--one to release your dog and one to catch your dog
- It works best to have someone release your dog and someone to catch your dog-- if you are solo there are many helpers to ask at the trial, just be sure to plan ahead.
- Be ready at the starting line-- pay attention to your run time and have your dog and releaser ready to go
- Be ready at the finish line--have your catcher and a leash at the finish line ready to catch.
- Don't forget to give your time card to the Timers Table.
- Your dog can run with collar and tags, and no muzzle --this is at your discretion
- Walk your dog back from the finish line to help them cool down, take advantage of dog water station and dog pool--this is specially important on warm days.
- As a courtesy to those running; do not walk near the course--even a small distraction can cause a dog to lose focus and slow down.
- Your getting exercise too!!
- Relax and have fun

Meet Philip Fullam --Guest Lure Operator from Rio Rancho New Mexico

I started in sighthounds in 1974 with an Irish Wolfhound and a Saluki. My first lure coursing experience was shortly afterwards, when my Wolfhound demonstrated a keen desire to chase the lure. She eventually became the first female LCM. Currently, I have two IW and am hoping the youngest will take to the lure. In 1982 I obtained my ASFA judges license, and have been active judging, lure operating and generally helping out since then (both ASFA and AKC Lure trials). A few years ago, I started to judge open field events, and that was enlightening. While not a big conformation person, I do enjoy owner handling my IWs, and have had some small successes. I have put on several judging seminars and done numerous lure operator trainings. Each time I feel I have come away understanding more and have been grateful for the questions and observations of those I have tried to provide information to. Currently I am president of the Lobo Lure Coursing Club in NM and serve on the board of directors of ASFA as 1st VP. Additionally, I am on several ASFA committees including the Judges Committee, Long Range Planning, and Field Trial Improvement.
